Contact Level

Organizations at the Contact Level agree to be in our database. We will communicate with you directly regarding projects that we believe are uniquely beneficial to your organization. Still, we will not add you to our email list or include you in our general invitations to events in our region.

Network Level

Organizations at the Network Level commit to the following:

- Regularly convey to the Project Lab all your needs, events, resources & potential projects.
- Commit to upholding and valuing a practice of unity and collaboration.
- Commit to prayer for specific collaborative projects and unity in the church of WNY.

The Project Lab serves our Network in the following ways:

- Regularly convey to you the collaborative events and projects happening in WNY.
- Distribute information for your organization to the rest of the Project Lab network.
- Network support for your collaborative events and projects.
- Praying for you and your projects.
- All organizations at the Network Level will sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Project Lab.

Partner Level

Organizations at the Partner Level commit to the following:

- All of the Network Level commitments.
- Mobilizing your people and resources for collaborative projects.
- Identify specific collaborative projects that your organization will implement.
- Contribute financially or in kind to the Project Lab's ongoing work.

The Project Lab serves our Partners in the following ways:

- All of the Network Level services.
- Provide assistance and expertise in the mobilization of your people and resources.
- Provide assistance and expertise to your collaborative projects.
- Provide vision and strategy for regional collaboration of God's people.
- All organizations at the Partner Level will sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Project Lab.
